1. Lorain opened the meeting at 1:00 p.m.
2. Katie motioned for the June 15, 2020 minutes to be approved as written. This was seconded by Wanda and unanimously approved.
3. Katie has obtained a list of names and telephone numbers for people living in Union age 55 and older. This list is about 54 pages long. Discussed and decided to have Katie ask Jeff Evangelos' office assistant for age 65 and older to make the list manageable for us to contact regarding the November 3rd election. Planned to start working on contacting in September as the deadline to register for the Nov. 3rd election is October 13th. Discussed doing both a mailing and phone calls.
4. Discussed updating the Aging in Place webpage on the Town of Union website. Jay informed us the town website is being updated and will not be available until late in August to add new material. Jay said changes UAP wants on this site will need to be given to Stacey in the town office.
5. Wanda, Lorain and Katie agreed to work in a subcommittee to review what is on the website and plan changes to our Resource List. Discussed the resource list needs to have descriptions (more information) on what is available at any given resource listed.
6. "Community Investors" is an AMERICORPS program that is putting together a resource guide for Knox County.
7. Discussed our senior luncheon planned for October 29th should be planned as a take-out/and or deliver by reservation meal. We will plan this more at our August meeting, but for now we are thinking of using top closing containers for the food.

9. Lorain reported on Come Spring food pantry and how the food is being delivered to recipients' cars. There is plenty of food available in our area.
