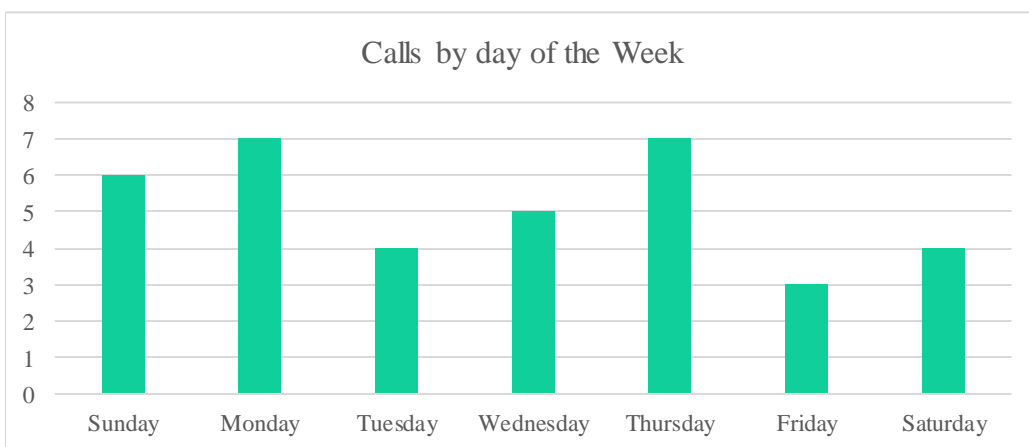

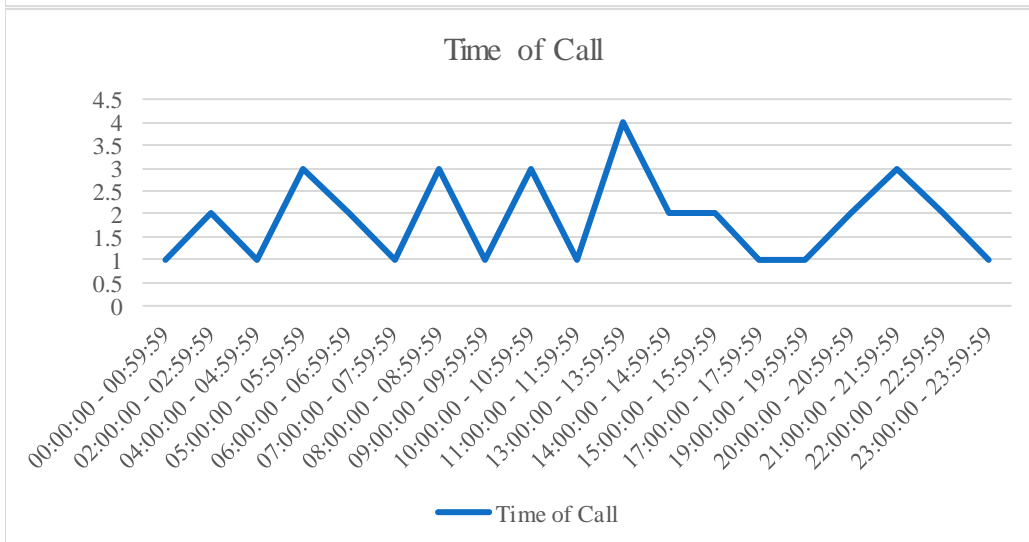

Good day, above you can see the stats for the rescue. We have been increasing our call volume, as of to date we have answered 441 calls for service. Also, as you can see since we have gone 24/7 per-diem our average en-route time has dropped to just above a 1 ½ minutes where it used to be about 9 minutes on average.

Maine EMS had adopted the new rules for EMS. These rules are what govern us as an EMS agency. These rules start to go into effect next month. One of the rules that was enacted was the need for all transporting EMS services to have a medical director. This means that I had to go and find a doctor that was willing to be a medical director for Union Rescue, I am pleased to say that Tyler Giberson from PBMC ER was willing and very excited to step into this roll. This also ties into the FDA for us to continue being able to carry certain medications and provide a paramedic service. I am still reviewing all the changes in the rules to see what other things we may need to do to comply with the new rules.
