AGING IN PLACE IN UNION COMMITTEE

Chairman Lorain Francis opened the zoom meeting at 1:00 PM

1. Bill made a motion to approve the minutes of the November 1st meeting as written and Debra seconded. Unanimous.
2. Lorain mentioned the St. Patrick's Day luncheon is our next one and we should start planning for it at our January meeting.
3. Debra spoke about three different grants she has applied for funding. She should hear back from December through February time frame. She will keep us posted on this.
4. TCC Update - Talks are continuing with the Committee and the Town. Bill mentioned he hopes to move forward on this topic at the next Selectboard Meeting.
5. Vose to home project of delivering books to people at home.

Flyers have been handed out at The Food Pantry and Sharon Caron had done outreach on this. So far, no interest. Holly stated she will add this to the announcements at Church on Sunday.

Lorain mentioned that the Food Pantry is having the same problem with not having as many elderly people come out because of Covid.

6. Marcy spoke about trying to get an answer about the Sand for Seniors program and that she was unsuccessful in getting any answers. Bill said he would find contact information for a Sheriff and try to find out about the program.
7. More discussion was held regarding loneliness and about making calls to the elderly. Holly mentioned that when she was in Eastport a successful program was developed but it took approximately 6-9 months to get established.

The calls must come from a trusted source, i.e.. the Church or Library.
