I hope everyone can enjoy the nice weather that we are having. June was a busy month for us with 61 calls that were answered. The second rescue is in full service and getting great use. It was the primary truck for the month and served the communities well. For the breakdown of the call information, it contains both rescues except for response times as with having the secondary truck changes the initial response time. That time is in the above is just based on the staffed rescue. So, for example the average time of tone to enroute for the second truck was 5.41 minutes with a combined average for both rescues being 2.16 minutes. This is why only the primary staffed truck times are posted above. Did not want citizens to think that things were sliding because they are not. The secondary truck was able to help with 8 calls that was not relied on mutual aid which saved money on not having to pay mutual aid. We did miss two calls and even if members had staffed the second rescue, we would still have needed mutual aid for one. There have been huge improvements and hope to continue down this path.
