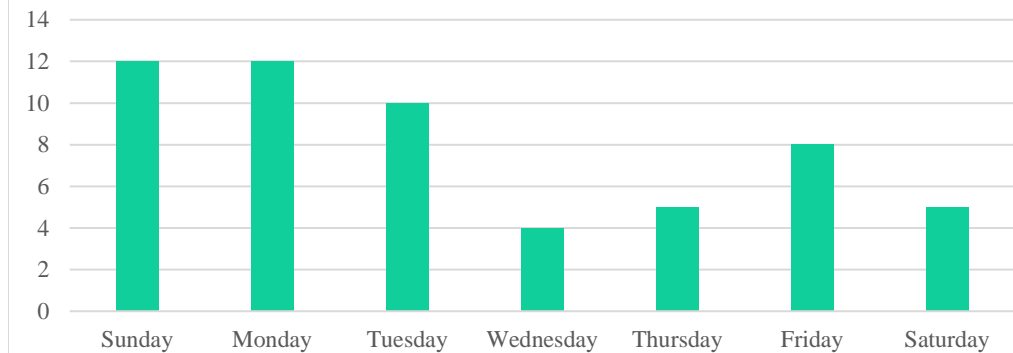

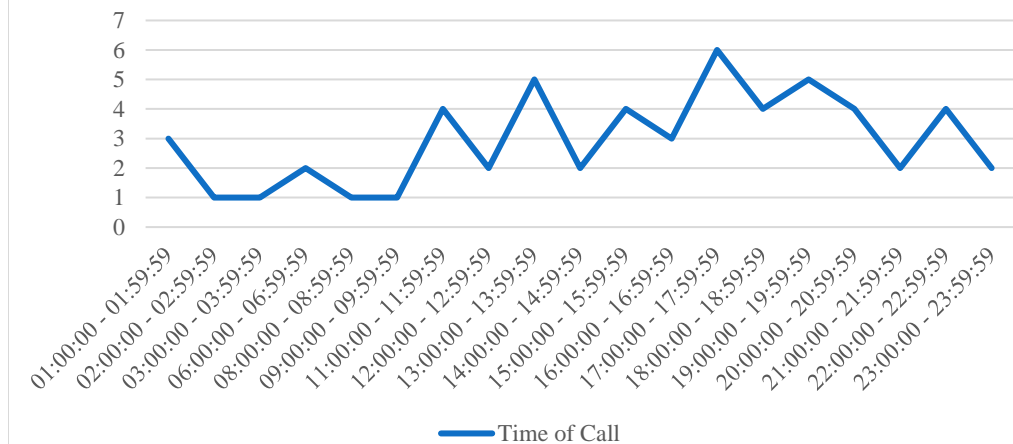

The month of May has been a very busy month for us. We responded to 56 calls for service, this is almost double the amount that we normally would respond to. We also went twice to other community's that we normally don't. As their EMS service was busy. The true be told this is becoming the normal for all EMS services across the state and country. This past month when our rescue was having normal service performed on it, the mechanics ran into a issue and had to keep it for 2 days, while this happened, we were not able to transport 3 patients and 2 of then were critical. WE also had a child break a wrist and to wait for the rescue to come from the hospital as that was the closet one available. While we have good mutual aid, making a patient wait 20 plus minutes for another ambulance to come and provide transport is not the best. This is why I have been saying that we need a second rescue not only to help with the second call that happens but if one breaks down, we have another rescue to use and not making the patient wait. We have back up with fire apparatus, but we do not with EMS apparatus
