The month of September began where the month of August left off. We continued mowing and ditching throughout the month. Ditching was done on Beote, Shepard Hill, Mt Pleasant and Brooks Road. We also changed a driveway culvert on Mt Pleasant and cross culverts on Guinea Ridge and North Union Road. The ditching work is begging to wind down and we'll begin to transition preparing for winter maintenance.

This month we began fall grading by spending the better part of two days on Barrett Hill. As time allows, our grader operator Tom Fontaine, will continue grading all dirt roads by the end of October. Hopefully our mowing season will be done in the next couple of weeks and then we'll focus on prepping trucks for winter.

Fine Line Pavement Striping from Hermon came down and painting a double yellow on the new chip seal on Sennebec and North Union Road. All of the roadwork is now finished on Coggins Hill, Townsend and Sidelinger, so All States will be here around the second week of October to do the final grading and paving.
