

# **WALKING TRACK AND MULTI-PURPOSE FIELD**

Hopefully you have read about the Recreation Complex Committee's plan to build a multi-purpose field, walking track and dog park. The William Pullen Fund, which is dedicated to youth, has voted to fund the purchase of a parcel off Route 17.

The Pullen Fund is dedicated to the youth of Union and the funds can only be spent on such items. The Trustees dedicate 30% to scholarships, 30% to yearly request, and bank the remaining 40% for a major project. That project is this multi-purpose area.

Once the Trustees' vote is confirmed by the Town, the committee will begin raising the funds to begin construction. It will not happen overnight, but the plan will be to build it piecemeal as funds are awarded.

It will be exciting to see a nice walking path, dog park, multi-purpose field and hopefully a hockey rink for winter skating. The plan is to do all this with grants and fundraising.

## **PAVING PROJECTS SCHEDULED FOR 2018**

In the 2018-19 budget we will be doing the following road improvements:

Paving: Clarry Hill Land, Rabbit Farm Road, Cole Road, Ayer Hill and Middle Road. Most will be shims and wear surfaces. Please contact me if you have questions on paving.

We will also be ditching Shepard Hill Road and other areas as funding permits.
